REGISTRATION

Registration for GSNC is through the online portal for Netball Australia. The links are included below with instructions. Payment is to be made at the time of registering. **REGISTRATIONS CLOSE MONDAY 20th FEBRUARY 2017.**

MEMBERSHIP

The Club invites all Good Shepherd Students, parents and their immediate family members, to register for the 2017 season. Membership is offered only to Good Shepherd families.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE (WWVP)

It is a requirement that all volunteers (coaches, umpires and officials) over the age of 18 hold their WWVP (Working with Vulnerable People) Cards. Registration with WWVP is free for volunteers and can be found following this link:

- Note: ACT Junior Championships will be held on 6-7 August (U11-12s) and 20-21 August (U13-15s). No NCNC rounds are played on these weekends.

LOCATION

The 2017 competition will combine the CNA (Canberra Netball Association) and BNA (Belconnen Netball Association) winter competitions, known as the NORTH CANBERRA NETBALL COMPETITION. Some divisions of all categories will play at either of two venues: CNA outdoor courts, Southwell Park, Northbourne Avenue, Lyneham; or BNA outdoor courts, Lhotsky Street, Charnwood.

Net Set Go! 'Net' Net is the program for 5-7 year olds providing the basic skills for starting netball. The program is delivered by Canberra and Belconnen Netball Association coaches at both locations. (the program does not include matches).
For Good Shepherd this would be Kindergarten children.

Net Set Go! 'Set' (previously Modified) Netball A non competitive round robin, no finals are played. Note: Modified game rules apply. For Good Shepherd this would suite players from Years 1-4. (Year 4 depending on skill level as these girls may also play up into the Juniors category)

FEES

- The fee schedule includes the umpires fees for the 2017 season.
- **Family discounts** are not offered for the 2017 netball season.
- A late fee of \$10 per player may apply for registrations received after the closing date as per the NCNC schedule.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- We will endeavour to have each team consist of approximately nine players and the committee will compile teams. However, if there are players who wish to

play in a team with another player of the same age group please indicate on the registration form. The Club cannot guarantee to meet all preferences but full consideration will be given.

- If your child would like to remain in an existing team please say so on the registration form.
- Whilst we can try to accomplish the above, please remember that we may not have the exact numbers to make the teams as such and some teams could end up with more or less players depending on registrations. We want to be able to place all players in a team and will do the best we can with what we have.
- First Preference is given to returning players in existing teams.

TRAINING

Training will take place at the Good Shepherd Netball Courts. Days and times will be finalised in consultation with coaches and players available days from the provided registration forms.

UNIFORMS

The GSNC uniform will be the Good Shepherd School Sports uniform. Specifically the sports t-shirt, Navy blue skirt or skort (sorry no shorts) and the sports tracksuit. This uniform is the registered uniform for the club and will be worn during games. Please note that tights are not permitted under skirts on the courts. But the school tracksuit pants may be worn by Modified/Set players. It is recommended that the girls wear a long sleeve white or navy top underneath their GS tshirt on the court during games for those freezing cold days. The school jumpers can be a bit bulky.

COACHES/MANAGERS/UMPIRES

Like all sports, netball relies on volunteers. Our Club looks to parents and senior playing members to assist as coaches, assistant coaches, managers and umpires to support players.

- All Modified and Junior teams require a Coach, Manager and Umpire.
- Someone will need to score each week.

If you can volunteer for any of these roles please complete a Coach or Umpires Form in the online domain. The link is provided below. The Club provides team kits and assists coaches and umpires with development and support. A pre-season briefing and kit collection will be held once teams have been finalised.

*** For Coaches**

For coaches it is recommended that you do the Australian Sports Commission 'Beginning Coaching General Principles' online course. The course contains five modules, covering a range of general coaching topics including the role and responsibilities expected of a coach, planning, safety, working with parents, communication, group management and inclusive coaching practices. PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS

The only fundraising that the GSNC does is the running of the school discos. It is a requirement for parents and senior players to assist on those evenings (1-2 discos per year).

The Club is committed to promoting netball and the personal development of players in accordance with the principles of good sportsmanship. All players, officials, parents and supporters are expected to abide by the NCNC Codes of Conduct and promote the best interests of the Club, the Good Shepherd School and netball. COMPETITION RULES

The NCNC By-Laws provide details of the competition rules and are available for viewing on the NCNC website under the "Resources" link. It is in the best interests of the game and will assist individual players if all members (players, officials and supporters) become familiar with and gain an understanding of the rules.

INSURANCE

All GSNC participants/players/volunteers will be covered by insurance under the ACT Netball Sports Insurance Scheme. GSNC does not accept liability for injuries incurred during games or while attending training sessions.

PRESENTATION DAYS AND AWARDS

Presentation events are held at the end of the season and all NetSetGo 'Set', Junior and Senior players receive recognition for their participation. In addition, the coach will choose a player to receive the Coaches Award for a Player's contribution and commitment throughout the season.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR 2017

Each member will need to log into their own MyNetball account. All existing members (previous players/coaches) have a MyNetball ID. New members can search MyNetball to see if they have an existing account and if not will be able to create one. Payment is made at the time of Registration online only and incurs a small transaction fee from the provider.
